Allowed Devices

- Skis
 - Must have a device to stop runaway equipment, such as bindings with brakes.
- Snowboards
 - Must have a device to stop runaway equipment, such as appropriate bindings or a leash from the binding to boot.
- Telemark skis
 - Must have a device to stop runaway equipment, such as leashes.
- Mono skis
 - Must have a device to stop runaway equipment, such as bindings with brakes.
- Snowblades
 - Must have a device to stop runaway equipment, such as appropriate bindings.
- Integrated ski boots
 - Must have metal edges

Devices Allowed with Restrictions

- Skibikes/Snowbikes/Snow Trikes
 - Allowed under the following parameters
 - Bike must have no more than three (3) skis.
 - Must have metal edges on skis.
 - Must have a seat.
 - Only one (1) rider per bike.
 - Must have a braking device to stop runaway equipment.
 - Must be designed to load lift without requiring slowing or stopping.
 - Must be loaded within envelope of chair; bike counts as a rider on the chairlift.
 - No homemade bikes.
 - May be restricted in certain areas and lifts for safety concerns.
- Adaptive Devices
 - Must have metal edges and a device to stop runaway equipment.
 - All adaptive devices must be able to be safely loaded and unloaded from chairlifts.
 - No homemade devices allowed.

- Snowskates and Snowdecks
 - Allowed, but must have metal edges and a device to stop runaway equipment, such as straps or leashes.

Prohibited Devices

- Bicycle-converted snowbikes
 - Only factory snowbikes/skibikes as defined are allowed. No homemade snowbikes allowed.
- Plastic snowboards or skis
 - Plastic snowboards or skis, i.e. lacking metal edges are considered toy and are not allowed.

- Snow Scooter
 - This device not acceptable anywhere at the resort.
- Infant carrier
 - Infant carriers of any type are not permitted while skiing or snowboarding.
- Body Sled
 - Affixing sleds or skis to your body is dangerous and not allowed at the resort.
- Ghosky
 - This sled-like device is not permitted on ski terrain and can only be used in the sledding area.
- Airboard
 - This snow body-board like device is not permitted on ski terrain and can only be used in the sledding area.
- Inflatable snow toys
 - Tubes and other inflatable toys used for sledding not permitted on ski terrain and can only be used in the sledding area.
- Toboggans, sleds and discs
 - Toboggans, sleds, and discs used for sledding not permitted on ski terrain and can only be used in the sledding area.
- Snowshoes
 - Snowshoeing and hiking is not permitted on ski terrain.
